The Graduate Study Room (411), located on the north side of the fourth floor, is intended exclusively for the use of Bloomsburg University graduate students who are in need of a quiet study area. Others are not permitted in the room at any time. As with other areas of the Library, food and beverages (except those in approved containers) are not permitted. Since the area is intended for serious study, it is expected that users will maintain proper decorum while in the room. While every effort will be made to make the room secure, the Library assumes no liability for lost, stolen, or damaged material.

Lockers are available in the room on a first-request basis. Keys may be acquired at the Circulation Desk located on the first floor of the Library. Rules and regulations governing the use of lockers will be supplied when the requests for keys are made.

The Graduate Study Room is equipped with several computer stations. If problems of any sort occur they should be reported to the Circulation Desk by using one of the intercom phones conveniently located on the fourth floor.
